What You Can Expect To Do

HOWTH COASTAL BOAT TOUR

- Meet Ireland's Eye Ferries crew at the ferry pontoon.
- Make sure to ask for Ireland's Eye Ferries crew if you have difficulty finding us.
- When onboard you can sit or stand while holding onto the rails for the duration of the boat tour.
- The tour circumnavigates the Island of Ireland's Eye enjoying fantastic views including cliffs & caves, spotting amazing marine and wildlife along the way while enjoying some interesting stories from your crew.





Where to Meet

-  **Location:** Ferry Pontoon 1, West Pier, Howth Harbour
-  **Landmark:** Opposite the entrance to Aqua Restaurant
-  **Look for:** Orange boats operated by Ireland's Eye Ferries

How To Get To Us



WALK / CYCLE

If you live nearby, bring a bike lock if cycling



CAR

Parking is available near the West Pier, but it can be busy.



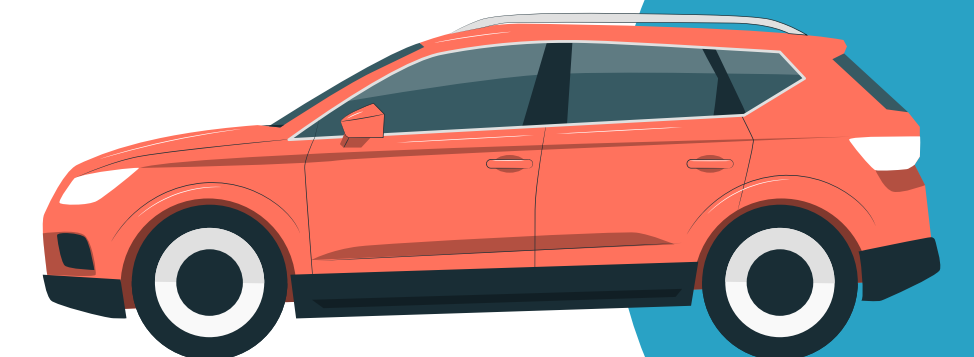
BUS

Take Bus H3 or 6 and get off at Howth Harbour stop.



TRAIN

Take the DART train to Howth Station, then walk 5 minutes to the pier.





Who Will Meet You

- You will meet one of our crew from Ireland's Eye Ferries at the top of the **Ferry Pontoon**. They will be looking out for you.
- There are other companies operating on the pier so if you can't see us when you arrive ask for **Ireland's Eye Ferries** or call us on **+353 86 077 3021**
- Our team are very helpful and friendly and will do their best to make sure you are comfortable and have a great experience.

It's very important that you listen to the crew at all times.





What To Bring

- You will also need to wear clothes and shoes that you are warm and comfortable in.
- We also suggest you bring a **rainproof jacket, hat, sunglasses, and a bottle of water.** We have hats and sunglasses in case you find that you need them as sensory tools.
- It's always a good idea **to wear sun protection cream.** Put this on before you come and bring it with you so you can put on more as needed.





How Long is the Boat Tour

- You can expect to be on the boat for 50 minutes. It takes another five minutes to get on and off the boat so in total it will take 60 minutes
- Sometimes we might need to contact you before the boat tour if the weather is too windy.
- Don't worry we can reschedule to another day or offer you a full refund.





Who Can Come With Me

- If you are an adult and you need support, bring a trusted adult with you.
- If you are a child, come with parent(s), guardian(s), brothers, sisters or other family members.
- These people can book the tour and come with you or they can wait nearby at the end of the West Pier



Toilets

- Look out for the toilets at the entrance to the West Pier.
- They are beside the train station **opposite Howth Market.**
- It is a good idea to use the toilet before you come on the boat as there are no toilet facilities onboard.
